Once teams have been announced, we will use the GroupMe app for all team communication. The player (if allowed) and the parent will be sent an invitation to join the private thread.

SEASON EXPECTATIONS

PARENTS

CHAA (Coastal Homeschool Athletic Association) is a volunteer-led organization. For us to operate smoothly, parents are asked to volunteer throughout the season in various roles. Our parents are needed to set up the gym, work the gate, line judge, libero tracking, scorebook, scoreboard operator, and clean-up the gym.

Parents are expected to be positive and supportive on the sidelines. Our players will be nervous and look to their parents. If the parents are positive and upbeat, it will help the girls play better.

Respecting the refs is a must.

Please have your player arrive 10 minutes prior to practices and an hour prior to games - unless the coach tells them otherwise.

Middle School is required to help set up the net.
High School is required to take down the net.

Attendance Policy

Consistent attendance is essential for team growth and success. Players are expected to attend practices, games, and tournaments. If you have to miss, please notify your coach in advance.

Effort, Sportsmanship & Communication

We value hard work, a positive attitude, and respect—for coaches, teammates, referees, and opponents. Every player is expected to give their best effort at every practice and game. We win with humility and lose with grace. Open and respectful communication is key: athletes should feel comfortable asking questions, taking feedback, and addressing concerns with maturity.

SEASON EXPECTATIONS

UNIFORMS

Uniforms will be given to players and must be returned to their coach at the end of the season.

Practice: Players must wear practice shirts, athletic shorts, proper volleyball shoes, and kneepads.

Games: Full uniform is required—jersey, warm-up shirt, black spandex/shorts, white socks, volleyball shoes, and white kneepads.

Please arrive dressed and ready to warm up.

Gear Care Tips:
