1. 4. We believe that man was created in the image of God but fell into sin through the disobedience of Adam and is, therefore, lost, unable to justify himself before God. (Genesis 1:26,27, 2:16,17, 3:6, Romans 3:10,23, 5:12,18)
5. We believe that salvation is the free gift of God given to the sinner by grace and received by personal faith in Jesus Christ alone, as Savior and Lord, whose substitutionary death on the cross paid the penalty for man's sin. This free gift of salvation is not received by any personal works whatsoever. (Ephesians 2:8,9, Titus 3:5, John 1:12, 5:24, Romans 5:15, 6:23, 10:9-13, Acts 16:31)
6. We believe that the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to convict and regenerate mankind, and to indwell, guide, instruct, and empower the believer for godly living and service. (John 16:7-14, Titus 3:5, I Corinthians 6:19, 12:13, Romans 8:14, Ephesians 5:18)
7. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28-29, I Thessalonians 4:16, Revelation 20:4-5, 20:12-15)

PLAYER CONDUCT EXPECTATIONS

- You can NOT keep jersey. Uniforms are property of CHAA.
- CHAA expects outstanding sportsmanship.
- CHAA expects honorable behavior on and off the field, including online.
- During practice, have fun, but we are here to learn.
- No temper tantrums or cussing.
- There will be times of disappointment & frustration. Hold your head up and learn from it. Our goal is to coach you into becoming honorable men & women.
- Show respect towards the officials at all times.
- Do not be late to practice/game.
- Athletes will be made to possibly sit the bench during a game if practices are missed. Missing a practice means you have missed optimal learning and can not be adequately prepared for a game.
- Athlete is not guaranteed to play every game. We are a high school level athletic association and we play to win. If you do not get a chance to play, use this time for growth, learning and camaraderie.
- If you play another CHAA sport, which meets at the same time, let your coach know, so a plan can be made with the other coach. You should not be punished or miss play time during a game in this scenario. If you must chose between a game or practice at the same time, the game takes precedence.
- Communication is key. If you **MUST** be late or miss due to illness or injury, you or your parent must reach out to the Coach.
- Do not have your parents talk to me about you. You talk to me about you. If you have a question, concern, dislike, want a different position, want more playing time, etc. you come to me directly.
